## MASTER OF ARTS IN INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES (M.A.)

## Purpose

The Master of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies program trains students to be interdisciplinary researchers able to discern the best of multiple fields in order to answer relevant questions for today. Students in this program will be trained to think and see through the paradigm of research that they may explore the world looking for answers to questions that have yet to be asked.

## **Program Learning Outcomes**

The student will be able to:

- Analyze knowledge of the literature of the discipline of two areas of study by examining the interdisciplinary relationship of each discipline.
- Integrate biblical principles through a professional and interdisciplinary context.
- · Synthesize the knowledge gained from their study across disciplines.

#### Program Specific Admissions Requirements

In addition to the general admission requirements, admission to candidacy in the *M.A. in Interdisciplinary Studies* program requires:

- 1. Earned baccalaureate degree or its equivalent from an institution accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education (e.g., SACSCOC, TRACS, ABHE, etc.)
- 2. An undergraduate cumulative GPA of 2.50 or above (on a 4.00 scale)
- 3. TOEFL (if applicable)

Students who do not meet the minimum Good Standing GPA requirement may be admitted on Academic Caution status. Students who have an undergraduate GPA below 2.00 will not be admitted to the program.

## Transfer Credit

Students may transfer up to 15 credit hours from an accredited institution subject to department approval. In order to transfer credit, students must have earned the minimum grade of C-, and courses must have been completed within 10 years of the start date of the program. Credits from a prior degree on the same academic level earned through Liberty University are considered transfer credits.
