- A maximum of $50 \%$ of the program hours may be transferred if approved and allowable, including credit from an earned degree from Liberty University on the same academic level
- 3.0 GPA
- No more than two grades of C may be applied to the degree (includes grades of C+ \& C-)
- No grade of $D$ or below may be applied to the degree (includes grades of $D+\& D-)$
- Degree must be completed within 5 years
- Submission of Degree Completion Application must be completed within the last semester of a student's anticipated graduation date
